

Image Map + Link Fragments Homework  
Assignment 3  
CS403 section 2  
Due: Oct 4, 2011

This assignment is an exercise in working with image maps and link fragments. The web page you'll have to reproduce is shown on the backside. Download the main image from <http://pubpages.unh.edu/~cs403s2/images/sportsplan.png>.

As with any image, you will need to add the text that will appear when the image can't be displayed – “Proposed Field Plan” - and when the user moves their mouse over the image – “Fields Planned for Completion Summer, 2012” Of course, the tooltip will only show up in an area not defined in your map!

Your image map should allow the person browsing the page to click on three separate areas of the image. Clicking on the baseball field should take the user to the section titled “Baseball Field.” Clicking on the pool should take the user to the section titled “Town Pool”. Clicking on the track, shown as a two circles one inside the other, should take the user to the section entitled “Running Track”.

The background image can be downloaded from <http://pubpages.unh.edu/~cs403s2/images/graph.gif> and the blue shim that “borders” the text within the sections noted above can be downloaded from <http://pubpages.unh.edu/~cs403s2/images/shims/blue.gif>.

To get the right coordinates, create a SEPARATE page, containing the following code (or something like it – you need a value for the href, but anyone will do):

You don't need to pass in this page it's just a tool to help you find the coordinates you'll need to create the image map.

Also, near the top of each page, add the following comment, replacing my name with yours.

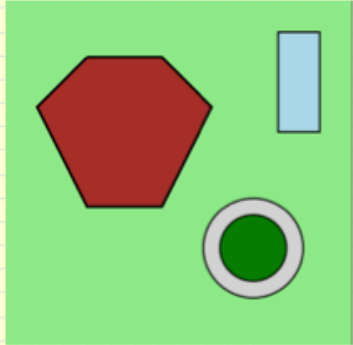

I always put it right after the <head>, but it doesn't have to be there.

Once you are done, print out each source HTML file and hand that in. It must be a legal HTML page, so watch your start and end tags. You don't need to print the page from the browser, just the HTML source file from notepad or textedit or your choice.
